We encourage all members to stay involved, attend meetings, and take part in the many activities on offer as we begin another exciting Probus year together.

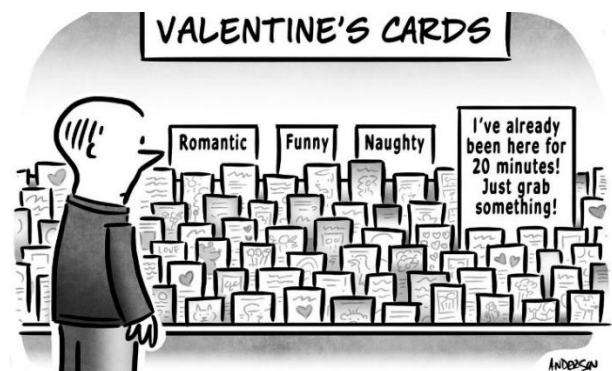

The primary role of a PSPL Representative Member/Director is, in conjunction with the Board, to ensure the continued growth and success of Probussouthpacific in Australia and New Zealand.
